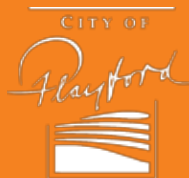

Social support programs

Friendly Visiting Program

Volunteers visit people at home on a regular basis offering friendship, information and support, such as talking on topics of interest, assisting with hobbies or going for a walk.

Friendly visiting provides opportunities to make new social connections and build meaningful relationships.

Beyond friendly conversation, participants and volunteers may exchange tips and resources, share experiences and connect with others in their community.

Phone Support Program

Provides social connection through regular phone contact with a volunteer offering friendship, information and support.

Coffee and chat

A program providing relief from social isolation and building connections within the community for older people, people with a disability and their carers

How do I access these programs?

1. Contact the Coordinator to make an appointment
2. An assessment will be arranged to find out your needs and interests
3. The Coordinator provides ongoing information, advocacy and support
